### **ELIANT Christmas letter 2009**

We have a great big Christmas favour to ask

*Dear friends of ELIANT,*

in a few days' time we will have got there: the ELIANT campaign will have collected 1 million signatures for the ELIANT charter from all round the world, and thus will leap the first great hurdle. But now the second and decisive hurdle awaits us: as European citizens' initiative, under article 11, paragraph 4 of the Lisbon Treaty, we must still gather a million signatures exclusively within Europe. This means we need a further 140,000 signatures from the 27 EU countries – which will make us one of the first EU citizens' initiatives to actually reach this goal.

So our great big Christmas wish is that all can help in collecting the EU signatures we still need as quickly as possible. The ELIANT campaign core members ask all supporters, anthroposophic institutions and anthroposophic associations in Europe to contact their own networks again in a joint action to achieve this goal and to pass on this request to as many Europeans as possible. In the attachment you can see the overview of which countries, additionally, have not yet managed to collect the desired number /quota of signatures. We would be very pleased if those who read this letter could make particular efforts to mobilize their contacts and networks in these countries.

We very much hope we can manage this last, necessary step together. Please support us in these efforts!
